Job Description:

The 111-bed American Family Children's Hospital, is the only facility in Madison exclusively devoted to the care and treatment of children. Our 21 bed PICU cares for over 1100 patients per year, representing the full spectrum of pediatric illness and injury. The division of pediatric critical care medicine has a current complement of 12 faculty, 6 critical care fellows and a growing APP program. The Department of Pediatrics has an outstanding, growing, and diverse group of 175 faculty, with all pediatric and surgical subspecialties represented. UW is a Level I pediatric trauma center, and serves as a major neonatal, pediatric and adult ECMO referral center. This position will primarily provide clinical care on our cardiac critical care team, joining a dedicated multi-disciplinary team supporting the growth of our cardiac program. The AFCH Heart Program is ranked in the top 50 programs by US News and World Report and recently received a top ranking by the Society of Thoracic Surgery.
